

Copyright Notice to Authors

The following terms apply to all submissions to the Open Access Journal «MediaEducation (Zeitschrift MedienPädagogik)» through the submission portal <https://www.medienpaed.com/about/submissions>. Any changes to these terms by the author are not accepted, even if they are known, unless otherwise agreed in individual cases and in writing.

§ 1 Objective

The author leaves the submitted contribution to the editor¹ of the journal «MediaEducation» for the purpose of publishing it in the Open Access Journal «MediaEducation» on www.medienpaed.com under the license *Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International (CC BY 4.0)*.

§ 2 Guarantee of authorship

2.1 The submitting author assures that he / she alone has all the rights of the article or acts with the explicit consent of all involved authors, and therefore is fully entitled to grant the rights listed in section 3.

2.2 The author warrants that the article does not infringe any rights of third parties (e.g. copyrights or personal rights) – in particular that in the case of the use of parts from third party works the necessary permission of the copyright holder exists – and that he / she does not violate any legal provisions. The author obligates himself to reimburse any damage caused by a breach of this warranty to the publisher.

2.2 For contributions in the sections «Special Issues» and «Occasional Papers», which require an original publication, the author assures that the contribution has neither been completely or partially published in another outlet or in any other way.

§ 3 Transfer of rights

The author transfers the rights of the contribution for the purpose of publication in the journal «MediaEducation / MedienPädagogik» under the license *Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International (CC BY 4.0)* to the publisher. The publisher is not obliged to publish and distribute the contribution, there is no obligation to publish.

In the case of an original publication, the author may negotiate additional contracts for the non-exclusive dissemination of the contribution published in the journal, as long as the original publication in «MediaEducation» is referred to and the conditions of the *CC BY 4.0* license are complied with.

§ 4 Submission of the contribution

- 4.1 If the submitted contribution deviates from the usual standards, the publisher must notify the author in writing and in detail within a reasonable period of time. The author obligates himself to make any necessary corrections and to return the improved text to the publisher within a reasonable period of time to be specified by the publisher. If the author does not return the corrected text on time, the publisher is entitled to reject the contribution. The guidelines on the peer review process published on the website of the journal «MediaEducation» apply (<https://www.medienpaed.com/about#peerReviewProcess>).
- 4.2 The publisher informs the author about the planned publication date of the contribution as well as any postponements.

§ 5 Fee (or article processing charges; APC)

No fee or APC apply.

§ 6 Final provisions

- 6.1 Upon submission of the contribution, the author agrees to this agreement.
- 6.2 The above provisions also apply to the legal successors in the case of the death of the author.
- 6.3 Exclusively Swiss law is applicable to this agreement.
- 6.4 If disputes arise in connection with this agreement, the parties shall endeavour to settle their differences amicably before initiating judicial proceedings. Place of execution and jurisdiction is Zürich.
